ELECTRONIC FILING AS A REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION

- 1. The Plaintiff is requesting permission from the Court for the limited purposes of this lawsuit to be allowed to submit his filings electronically under FRCP 5(B)3B.
- 2. Wright has a severe and rapidly progressing medical condition (neuropathy and myopathy) which involves frequent medical appointments. He is rated 100% physically disabled (30% Service-Connected Post Traumatic Stress Disorder) by the Veterans Administration, and the chronic pain caused by his
