**ORDER**

Before the court is Plaintiff’s Motion for Miscellaneous Relief, (Doc. # 19), in which Plaintiff requests permission to submit his filings in this case electronically. Because the Northern District of Alabama’s CM/ECF Procedures do not allow pro se litigants to file electronically, Plaintiff’s Motion (Doc. # 19) is **DENIED**. *See* N.D. Ala. Civ. Admin. Procs. Manual for CM/ECF § I(E)(1) (2018) (“Parties proceeding pro se shall not file electronically.”).<sup>1</sup>

The court **REMINDS** Plaintiff that, if filing in person at the Clerk’s office is burdensome, Plaintiff may instead file court documents by mail.<sup>2</sup>
